ROGER STEELE

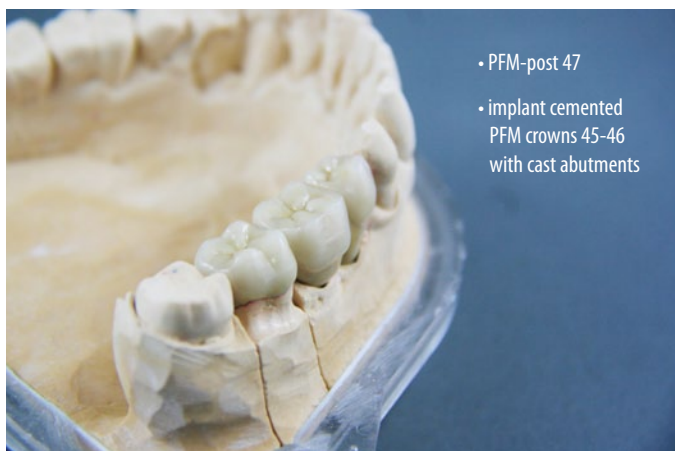
CROWN & BRIDGE DEPARTMENT SUPERVISOR
